Each CCS System needs to be registered with a valid licence in order to operate. There are three different licence types that can be used to register the CCS System.

THE CCS PRODUCT LICENCE

The Product Licence is a single user floppy based licence that can be moved from one computer to another. The Product Licence is not supported in the Windows NT, Windows 2000 and Windows XP operating systems. This means that this licence will become redundant and will be replaced by Software Licences.

THE CCS SOFTWARE LICENCE

The Software Licence is installed telephonically using a series of unlocking codes. This is the preferred method of registering the CCS System as it works with all of the current Windows operating systems. The Software Licence cannot be moved from one computer to another.

THE CCS TEMPORARY LICENCE

The Temporary Licence is a method of temporarily registering the CCS System over a given period of time. Temporary licences are normally used in emergency situations where the product or software licence malfunctions or to selectively allow new users a limited trial period after a training course or initial installation.

To check which of the above methods has been used to register your CCS system, click on the **Licence** SoftKey. The registration status, licence type and version number and the licence path are displayed on the System Licencing dialog.

CANCELLING A CCS LICENCE

Please remember that a one calendar month written notice is required when cancelling a CCS licence. CCS will continue to charge the user for the CCS System until the Software Licence or the Temporary Licence has been deleted or the Product Licence has been returned to CCS with the Product Licence on the product disk.
